

NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING OF LANDOWNERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all owners of lands located within the boundaries of SOUTH INDIAN RIVER WATER CONTROL DISTRICT: There will be a meeting of the Board of Supervisors followed by a meeting of the landowners of South Indian River Water Control District at 7:00 p.m. on September 20, 2018 in the auditorium of the Jupiter High School, 500 N. Military Trail, Jupiter, Florida, for the purpose of:

1. Electing two (2) Supervisors for terms of three (3) years each. At least one of the two (2) Supervisors to be elected must reside in the District. Candidates must own land in the District and must be residents of Palm Beach County.
2. Receiving annual reports and taking such action with respect thereto as the landowners may determine.
3. Setting compensation for the Board of Supervisors.
4. Transacting any other business as may properly come before the meeting.

Any interested landowner may examine the ballots under the supervision of the Supervisor of Elections. Any objection to the election must be filed in writing by a landowner with the Board of Supervisors no later than one (1) week from the date of the election.

If a person decides to appeal any decision with respect to any matter considered, a record of the proceedings will be needed for such purpose, and said person will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record shall include the testimony and evidence upon which any appeal is to be based.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act, any person requiring special accommodations to participate in the Board of Supervisors Meeting and the Annual Landowners Meeting because of a disability or physical impairment should contact the District at (561) 747-0550.
