

# South Indian River Water Control District (SIRWCD) Invitation to Bid (ITB)

### Section 1.0 - Instructions to Bidders

### 1.1 Overview

The South Indian River Water Control District ("SIRWCD" or "District") invites sealed bids from qualified parties for the removal and purchase of approximately 8,000 cubic yards of spoil material from the District Canal C Project. The District desires to remove the spoil pile estimated to be approximately 60 feet tall and located in close proximity to residential properties.

## 1.2 Invitation to Bid

Sealed bids must be hand-delivered to the District Office at 15600 Jupiter Farms Road. Jupiter, Florida 33478 no later than 12:00 p.m. (noon) local time on **Thursday**, **June 5**, **2025**. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at **1:00 p.m. on June 5**, **2025** at the same location. Late bids will not be accepted or considered.

The bid will be awarded to the highest responsive and responsible bidder. Full payment of the bid amount by the successful bidder must be received by the District no later than 12:00 p.m. (noon) on **Thursday, June 12, 2025**. If payment is not received by this deadline, the District reserves the right to award the project to the next highest responsive bidder meeting or exceeding the reserve amount.

Bidders are encouraged to visit the site prior to submitting a bid. Access to the site may be coordinated by contacting Chad Kennedy via e-mail at ckennedy@sirwcd.org.

## 1.3 Reserve Amount

A minimum bid amount (reserve) of \$100,000 has been established. The District will not accept any bids below this amount.

## 1.4 Scope of Work

A. The successful bidder will be responsible for the removal and use or lawful disposal of all spoil material from the designated site down to the original ground elevation, as indicated by the underlying grass or vegetative layer buried beneath the spoil. Materials shall be removed from the site on or before **5:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 31, 2025**. The spoil pile is located immediately adjacent to the east end of Canal C, as shown on Exhibit A. The bidder will not place any materials within the site.

- B. The successful bidder shall provide the equipment, labor, supervision, and incidentals necessary to remove the materials and all work must be performed in accordance with applicable environmental and safety regulations.
- C. The successful bidder shall not deposit, store, stockpile, or otherwise place any materials, equipment, or debris on the site, other than as necessary for the lawful removal of the spoil material and as expressly authorized by the District. Any unauthorized placement of materials may result in removal at the bidder's sole expense.
- D. All material must be completely removed from the site on or before July 31, 2025, by 5:00 p.m., without exception. The successful bidder shall have no right of access to the site after the removal deadline, and any spoil material remaining on-site after such deadline shall be deemed abandoned. The bidder shall forfeit any claim of ownership or interest in the remaining material, and the District may remove, dispose of, or otherwise manage the material at its sole discretion and at the bidder's expense, without further notice or obligation.
- E. The successful bidder shall implement and maintain best management practices (BMPs) in accordance with the District's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit

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requirements to prevent the discharge, migration, or erosion of spoil material in a manner that may negatively impact drainage systems or degrade water quality. The District reserves the right to assess a fee of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day for each day that any water quality or erosion issue remains unresolved following written notice to the successful bidder. Such assessment shall be in addition to, and not in lieu of, any other remedies available to the District.

F. The successful bidder will be required to execute a release and hold harmless agreement, attached as Exhibit C, under which the bidder shall assume full responsibility for the spoil material and any and all liability arising from its removal, transport, use, or disposal.

## 1.5 Reservation of Rights

The District reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or waive any irregularities or informalities in the bid process. District may cancel the solicitation if no responsive bids meet or exceed the established reserve amount.

# RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT SIRWCD ITB No 2025-01 Canal C Spoil Material Removal Project

This Release, Hold Harmless, and Inde	emnification Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into this

independent special district ("District"	'), whose address is 15600 Jupiter Farms Road, Jupiter, Florida
33478 and	, a Florida corporation (hereafter referred to as
"Bidder"), whose address is	·

WHEREAS, the District has awarded to Bidder the right to remove and purchase approximately 8,000 cubic yards of spoil material located adjacent to the east end of Canal C pursuant to the District's Invitation to Bid No. 2025-01; and

WHEREAS, Bidder desires to access the site, remove the spoil material, and assumes full responsibility for the handling, transport, disposal, and all consequences associated with such material.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Release and Waiver. Bidder hereby voluntarily and knowingly releases, waives, and discharges the District and its officers, agents, employees, board members, and representatives (collectively, "Released Parties") from any and all claims, actions, causes of action, demands, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, and expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising from or related to the removal, handling, transport, use, or disposal of the spoil material, including entry onto District property. This release includes, without limitation, any claims for bodily injury, death, property damage, or environmental liability, whether caused by the negligence of the District or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- **2. Hold Harmless and Indemnification.** Bidder shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the District, its officers, agents, employees, board members, and representatives from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, suits, liabilities, judgments, losses, fines, penalties, damages, costs, and expenses (including court costs and reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of or resulting from a) Bidder's performance or failure to perform under this Agreement; b) Bidder's removal, transport, handling, storage, use, or disposal of the spoil material; c) Any act or omission of Bidder, its employees, agents, subcontractors, or representatives; and d) Any violation of applicable laws, rules, or regulations. This obligation shall survive the completion of the work and expiration or termination of any related agreement.

## 3. Assumption of Risk

Bidder acknowledges and agrees that it is accepting the spoil material "as is, where is" with no warranties or representations by the District as to the condition, composition, or suitability of the material for any particular purpose. Bidder assumes all risks associated with the material and its removal, transport, and reuse or disposal.

## 4. No Transfer of Title or Liability

The District makes no representation or warranty as to title to the spoil material or any liability associated with its origin or content. All liability associated with the spoil material shall transfer to Bidder upon execution of this Agreement and payment of the bid amount.

#### 5. Governing Law and Venue

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of

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Florida. Venue for any dispute arising under this Agreement shall lie exclusively in a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the District is located.

## 6. Incorporation by Reference

The documents listed below are a part of this Agreement and are hereby incorporated by reference, as though fully set forth herein. In the event of inconsistency between the documents, unless otherwise provided herein, the terms of the following documents will govern in the following order of precedence:

- 1. Terms and conditions as contained in this Agreement.
- 2. Terms and conditions contained in ITB No. 2025-01
- 3. Bidder's response to ITB No. 2025-01 and any subsequent information submitted by Bidder during the evaluation and negotiation process.
